SURFACE PREPARATION

General:

All surfaces must be firm, dry and cleaned free of loose paint, dust, dirt, oil, grease, wax, chalk, rust, mildew or any other contamination or condition that would adversely affect the performance of the coating. De-gloss shiny surfaces by lightly sanding.† Repair cracks and fill voids.

†See warning for existing lead-based paint under Precautions.

New Surfaces:

Follow general surface preparation guidelines. Moisture content should be less than 12 % as measured with a moisture meter. If applying stain prior to application, closely follow the stain manufacturer's recommendations concerning dry time and surface preparation. Test in an inconspicuous area to ensure compatibility. At least two coats recommended. Light sanding (180-220 grit) beteen coats may be necessary to smooth wood grain raise.

Previously Painted Surfaces:

New paint should be allowed to cure at least 7 days prior to clear coat application. Darker colors may need longer to cure. Aged, shiny, painted surfaces may need to be sanded to create a surface profile for the coating to properly adhere. Test in an inconspicuous area to ensure compatibility and desired look.

To avoid lap marks, maintain a wet edge. Keep product from freezing. Do not apply when material, air, and/or surface temperature is below 50°F. For more information about stains, clear finishes, sealers, and wood preparation, please contact a Miller Paint associate.

THINNING
Apply at can consistency. If thinning is necessary to maintain workability, do
I. not exceed one-half pint of water per gallon. Stir product thoroughly, DO NOT
SHAKE.
